

FTP Speed Test

From any windows operating system

- 1) Click on START / RUN
- 2) Enter 'cmd' in the dialog box and click OK
- 3) At the command prompt, type 'ftp jupiter.isosat.net'
- 4) The User ID is 'speedtest', and the password is '1234'
- 5) Once logged in, type 'binary' to put the test in binary mode
- 6) Now type 'dir' to get a directory listing of the files on the site. The file of most interest will be '1mb.tst'
- 7) Download the file by typing 'get 1mb.tst'
- 8) When the download is completed, you will get a speed reading in bytes per second. Multiply by 8 to get kbps.
- 9) Now – upload the same file by typing 'put 1mb.tst'. You will get the same type of speed reading – again multiply by 8.
